

## Veterinary Medical Supplies Needed by The Gabriel Foundation

Our expanding flock has drastically increased our need for donated veterinary/medical supplies and equipment. These supplies are just a portion of our veterinary wish list to help us meet the needs of our current flock. We now have over 600 birds housed with us at one time and we are the only parrot welfare organization in the U.S. to have a staff veterinarian, clinic and small hospital. The learning opportunities that TGF provides to veterinary students, veterinary technician students, and visiting veterinarians from around the world are a unique opportunity for anyone with an interest in avian medicine to work with so many parrot species in one location under the guidance of our staff veterinarian. Our flock and others birds around the world benefit from our individual and flock approach to avian medicine comprised of birds with diverse histories.

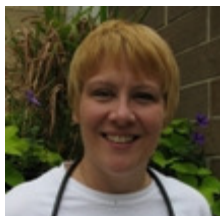
We understand that some of these items are costly, and may be difficult for individuals or clinics to donate. We are very willing to accept used equipment in good working condition. Bumps, dents or scratches make no difference to us or to our patients. In the event that veterinary or medical professionals may have updated their equipment and are no longer using the old items, we're hoping that some might be willing to donate these items.

Our staff veterinarian and flock will certainly put your donations to good use!

1. Abaxis avian rotors (VetScan) for blood chemistries
2. Exam gloves, non-latex (sm, med, lg)
3. 25 & 26 gauge hypodermic needles
4. 1 cc and 3 cc Terumo syringes with or without needles
5. Culturettes
6. Microainers (green and purple top with serum separator)
7. Microcentrifuge tubes (no serum separator)
8. Chlorhexidine concentrate
9. Hematocrit tubes, heparinized (1.1-1.2 mm)
10. Silver sulfadiazine cream
11. FlavoRx Syrup
12. FlavoRx Flavoring
13. FlavoRx sweetening enhancer
14. Heated isolettes (for critically ill patients)
15. Pulse oximeter
16. Tonopen
17. ECG
18. Small incubator for bacterial or fungal cultures
19. Water circulating heating pad with pump
20. Rigid 2mm endoscope
21. Teaching microscope
22. Ultrasound
23. Stainless steel surgical table
24. Stainless steel wet table
